THESE WORKS WILL INVOLVE SMALL TEAMS OF HIGHLY SKILLED OPERATIVES REMOVING THE EXISTING PAVING, UPGRADING THE DRAINAGE SYSTEM AND SUB-BASE AND THEN INSTALLING NEW PAVING ACROSS ALL THESE AREAS.

WHAT CITY CENTRE ACTIVE TRAVEL CONNECTIONS TO INTERCHANGE PHASE 1 WILL ACHIEVE

Improvement of the overall quality of the active travel surfacing and infrastructure along New Street and upgrading of the surrounding area (Temple Street, Lower Bennetts Hill, Ethel Street, Lower Temple Street, Eden Place, Chamberlain Passage). The improvement of this public space will provide a new aesthetic for the city through its retail core, creating attractive spaces for residents, businesses and visitors.

Improvement of the pedestrian and cyclist connectivity through the core of the city. This will provide safer and attractive connections to and from New Street Station to business and retail areas in the city

Provision of a safer pedestrianised streetscape within the city centre, while also improving the overall air quality by restricting vehicles within the New Street Area

Your Questions Answered

Will I still be able to access my home or business?

Yes – maintaining safe and convenient access is our top priority. CPC Civils will proactively manage traffic and pedestrian movement throughout the works. Clear routes will always be provided so that you can get where you need to go safely.

Are the steps in Victoria Square being completely replaced?

No – this is a refurbishment project, not a full replacement. The existing steps will be carefully upgraded to improve their condition and appearance, but the overall layout will remain the same.

How will deliveries and waste collection be handled?

We'll be working with you to ensure services continue as normal. Any changes to collection points or delivery routes will be communicated well in advance.
