

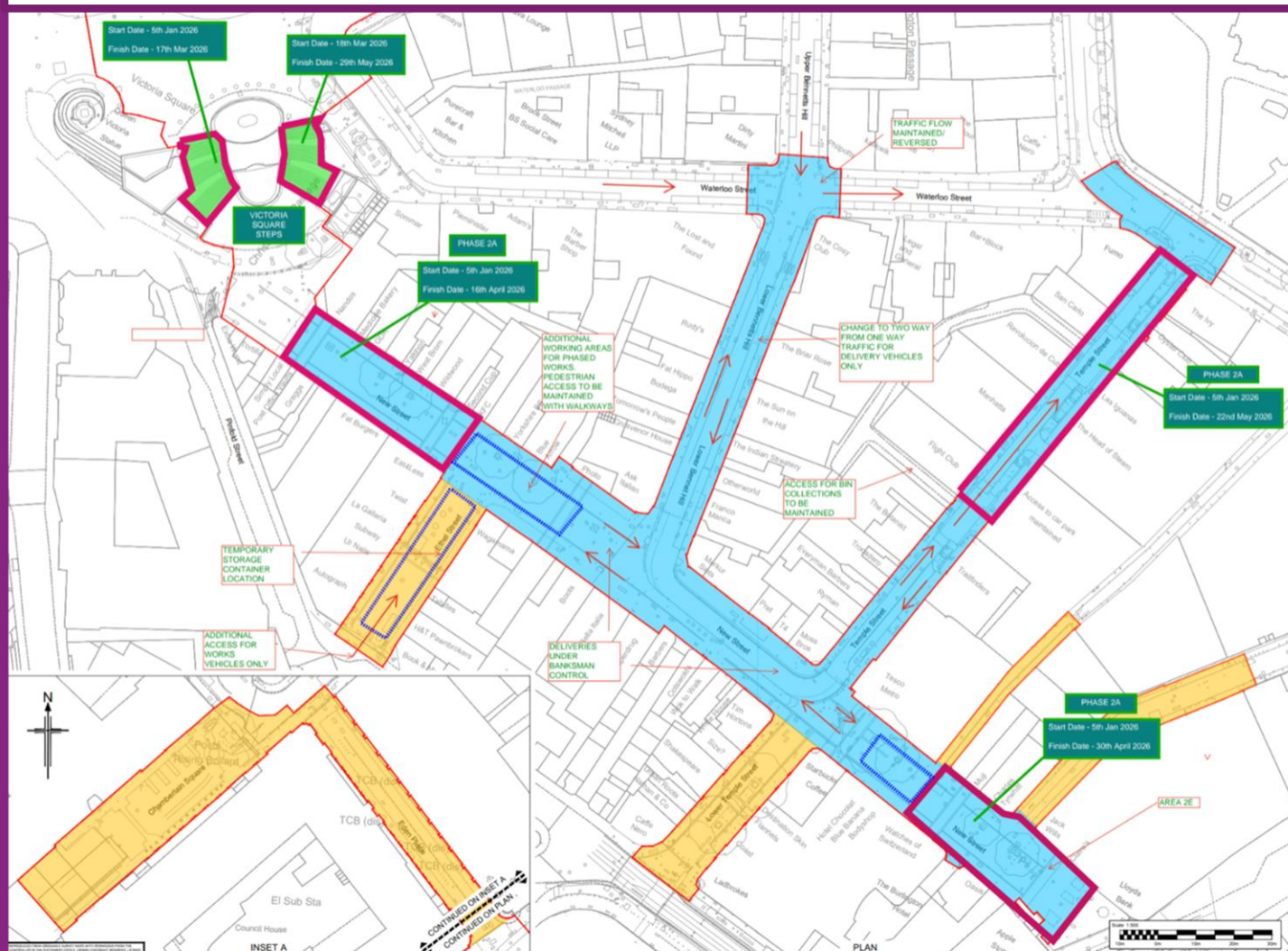
City Centre Active Travel Connections to Interchange Phase 1

CPC Civils have been awarded the City Centre Active Travel Connections to Interchange Phase 1 project by Birmingham City Council.

CPC Civils are delighted to be working with the City Council on this prestigious project.

The first phase of the project will commence in Victoria Square, New Street and Temple Street on Monday January 5th, 2026

This newsletter is to update you on the works areas that we will be commencing on in January and what arrangements will be in place to manage access for deliveries and bin collections during the initial stages of the works. On 5th January we will close the top of Temple Street and the middle section of the footway on both ends of New Street with access to shop frontages maintained. To maintain vehicle access Bennetts Hill and Temple Street will have two-way traffic flows controlled by our two dedicated Traffic Marshalls on site.



BUSINESS AND STAKEHOLDER INFORMATION SESSION

With the construction works scheduled to commence on 5th January 2026, we will be sharing details of the traffic management, access and phasing plans being proposed by our construction management team.

Construction Programme

Monday January 5th, 2026 – Friday May 22nd, 2026

Victoria Square

We commence the refurbishment project on the steps located to the left and right of The River Fountain.

Beginning on the eastern side (when viewed from below) CPC Civils will:

- Set up site – including the installation of Heras fencing and signage around the work area.
- Pressure wash the existing steps.
- Lift slabs, repair foundations where necessary and re-bed the cleaned slabs

New Street

We commence work to install new granite paving, new and improved lighting, drainage and street furniture.

In the work areas between Nandos and KFC and between Apple and Watches of Switzerland CPC Civils will:

- Set up the working area – including installation of Heras fencing and signage.
- Complete a site clearance.
- Remove existing paving.
- Commence excavation to formation.
- Remove spoil (materials) from working area.
- Install concrete base and lay granite paving.

Temple Street

We commence work to install new granite paving, new and improved lighting, drainage and street furniture.

In the work area between Fumo and Flight Club CPC Civils will:

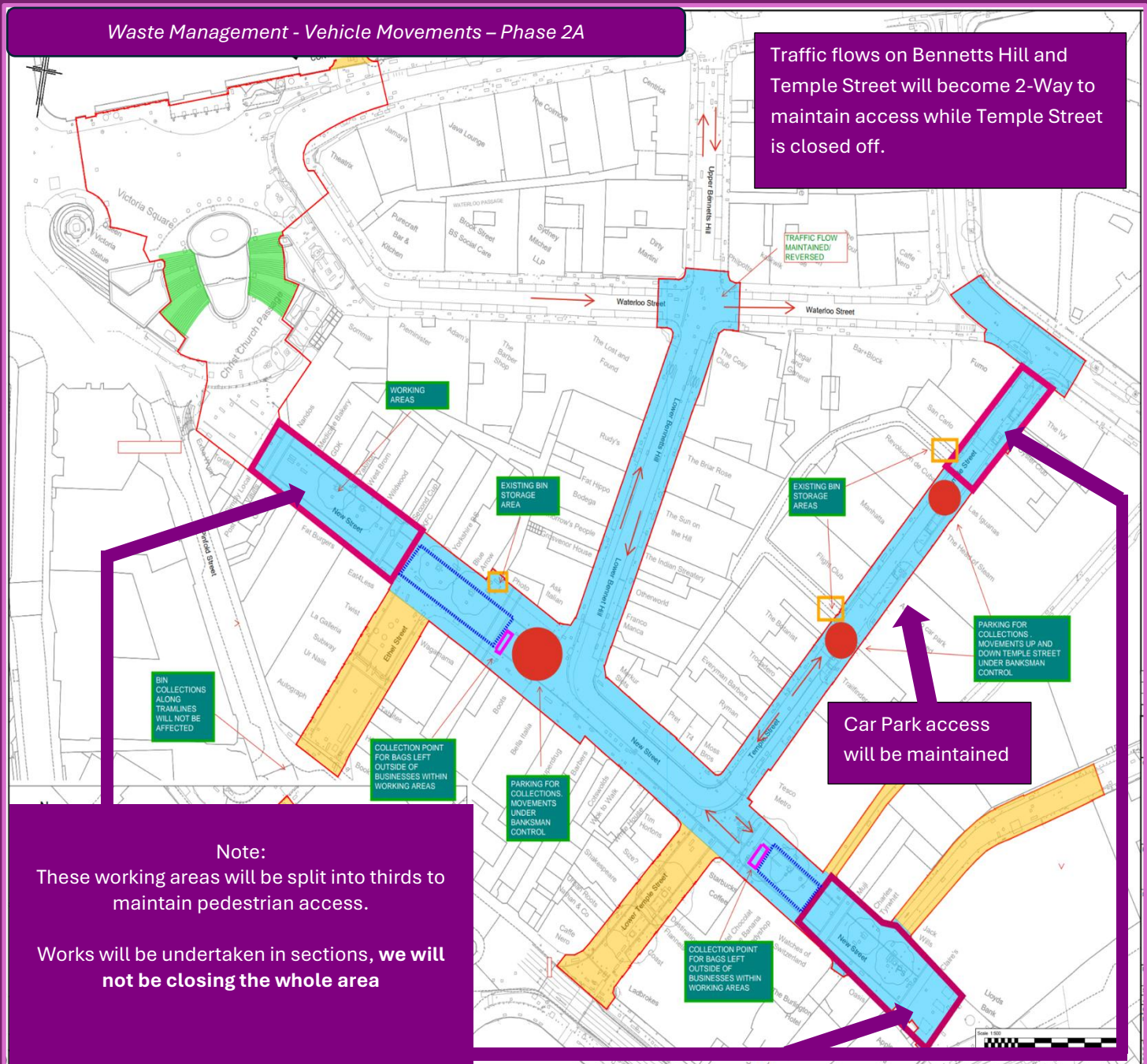
- Set up the working area – including installation of Heras fencing and signage.
- Complete a site clearance.
- Remove existing paving.
- Commence excavation to formation.
- Remove spoil (materials) from working area.
- Install concrete base and lay granite paving.

Traffic, Delivery & Waste-Management Overview

As part of the construction works taking place across Birmingham City Centre, a coordinated **vehicle, delivery and waste-management plan** will be in operation across **New Street, Temple Street and Bennetts Hill** with two dedicated Traffic Marshalls on site to co-ordinate access and deliveries.

These measures are designed to maintain safety, ensure access for businesses, and keep essential services running throughout the works.

Waste Management - Vehicle Movements – Phase 2A



Blue-shaded streets represent **live construction zones** where both delivery and waste-management vehicles will operate under **controlled movement**.

Access to these areas is restricted and may require banksman supervision for manoeuvres by our dedicated Traffic Marshalls.

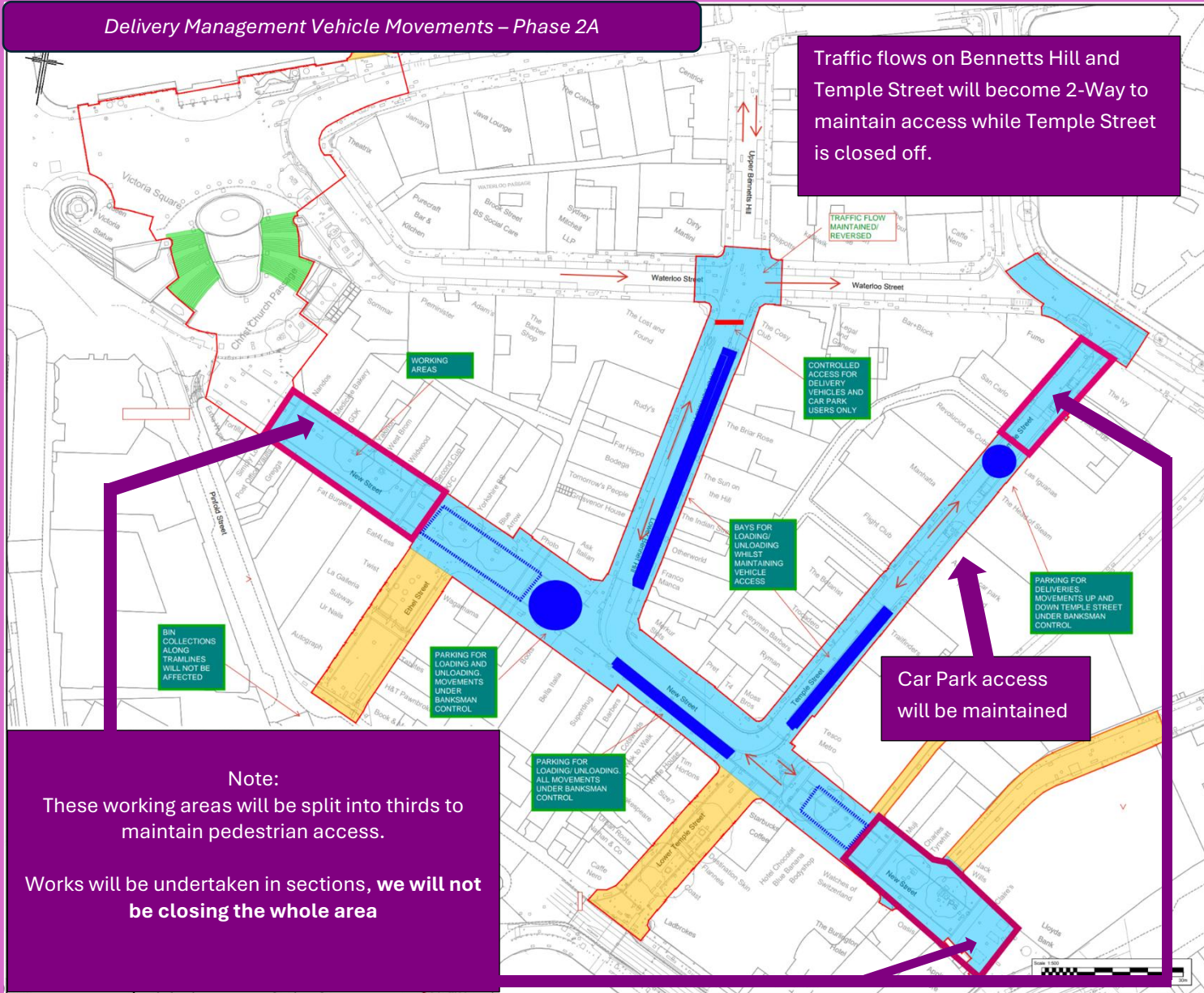
In addition to existing Bin Storage areas CPC will set up collection points for bagged-up general waste refuse collection.

These additional collection points are for businesses in the working areas who would normally leave bags on the footway at front of store.

Zones marked with Red Rectangles are construction zones within which CPC Civils construction teams will be operating.

Heras fencing will cordon off these zones, and **no access will be permitted unless authorised by a member of CPC Civils' construction management team.**

Delivery Management Vehicle Movements – Phase 2A



Deep-blue shaded zones (rectangles and circles) represent **loading/unloading bays – all parking will be suspended and loading/unloading only allowed.**

All movements in these areas will be under Banksman control.

Red arrows represent **the direction and flow of traffic that will be allowed.**

Vehicle access into Bennetts Hill will be controlled with access given to Emergency Services, Delivery Vehicles and Car Park users only
