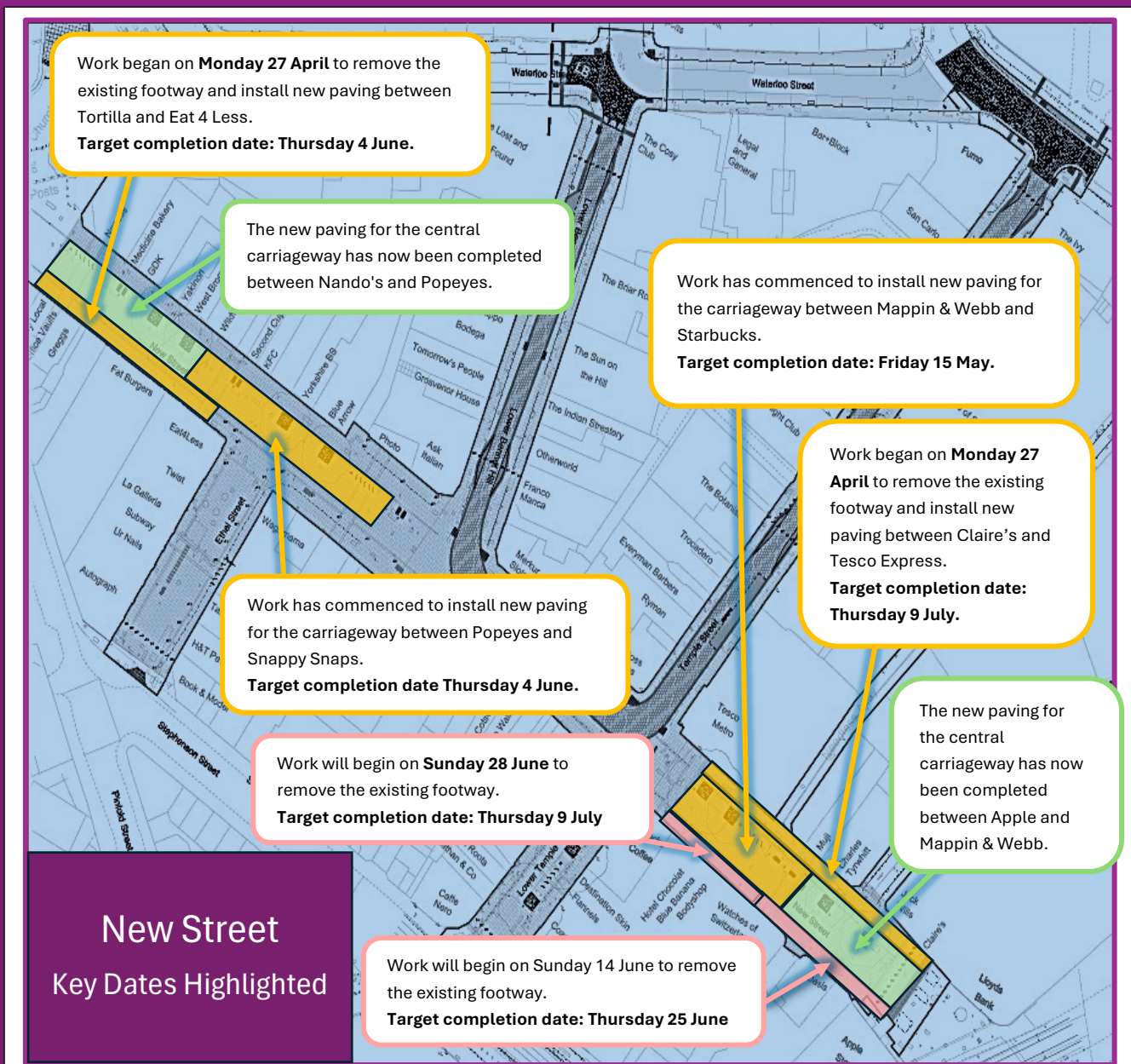


# City Centre Active Travel Connections to Interchange Phase 1



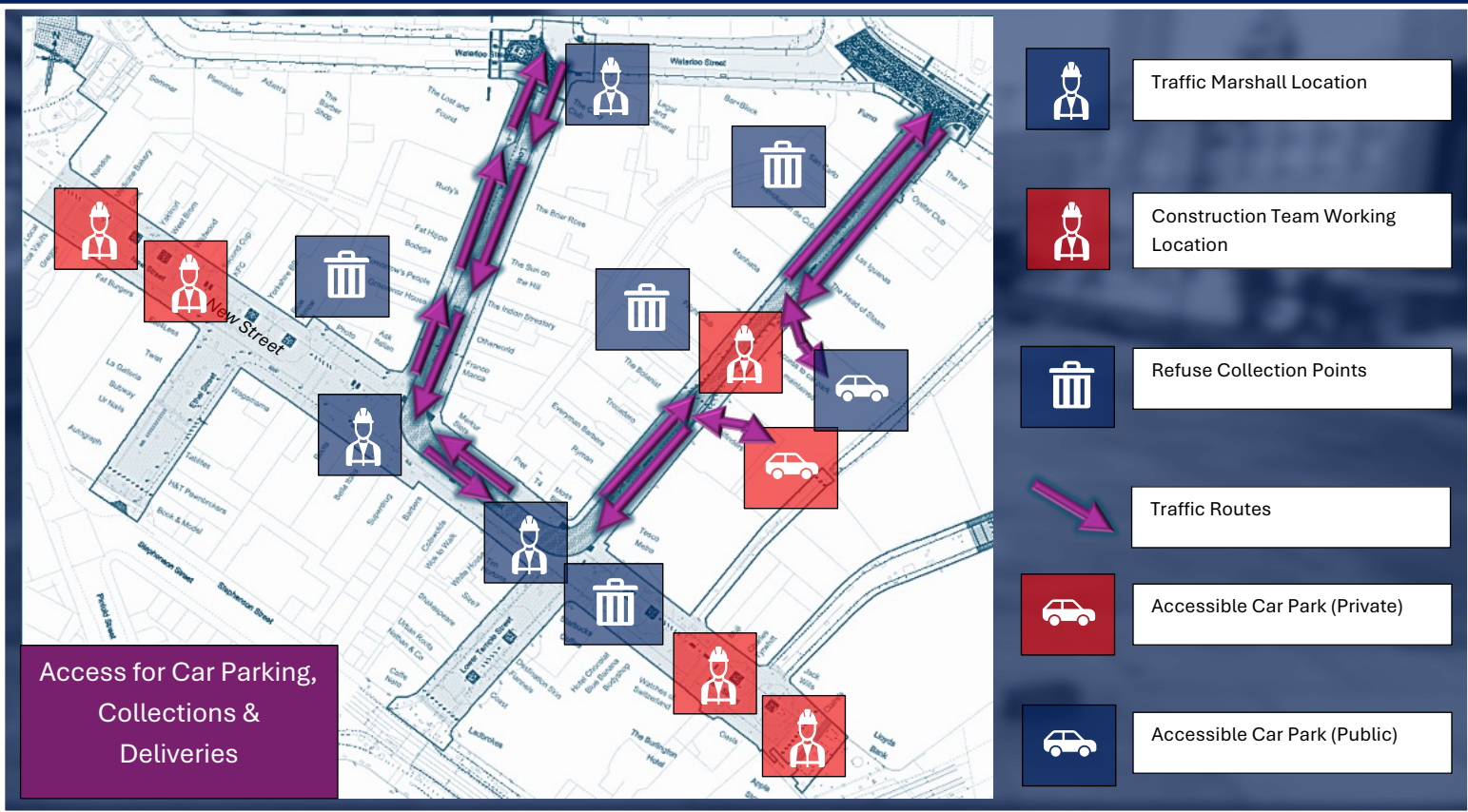
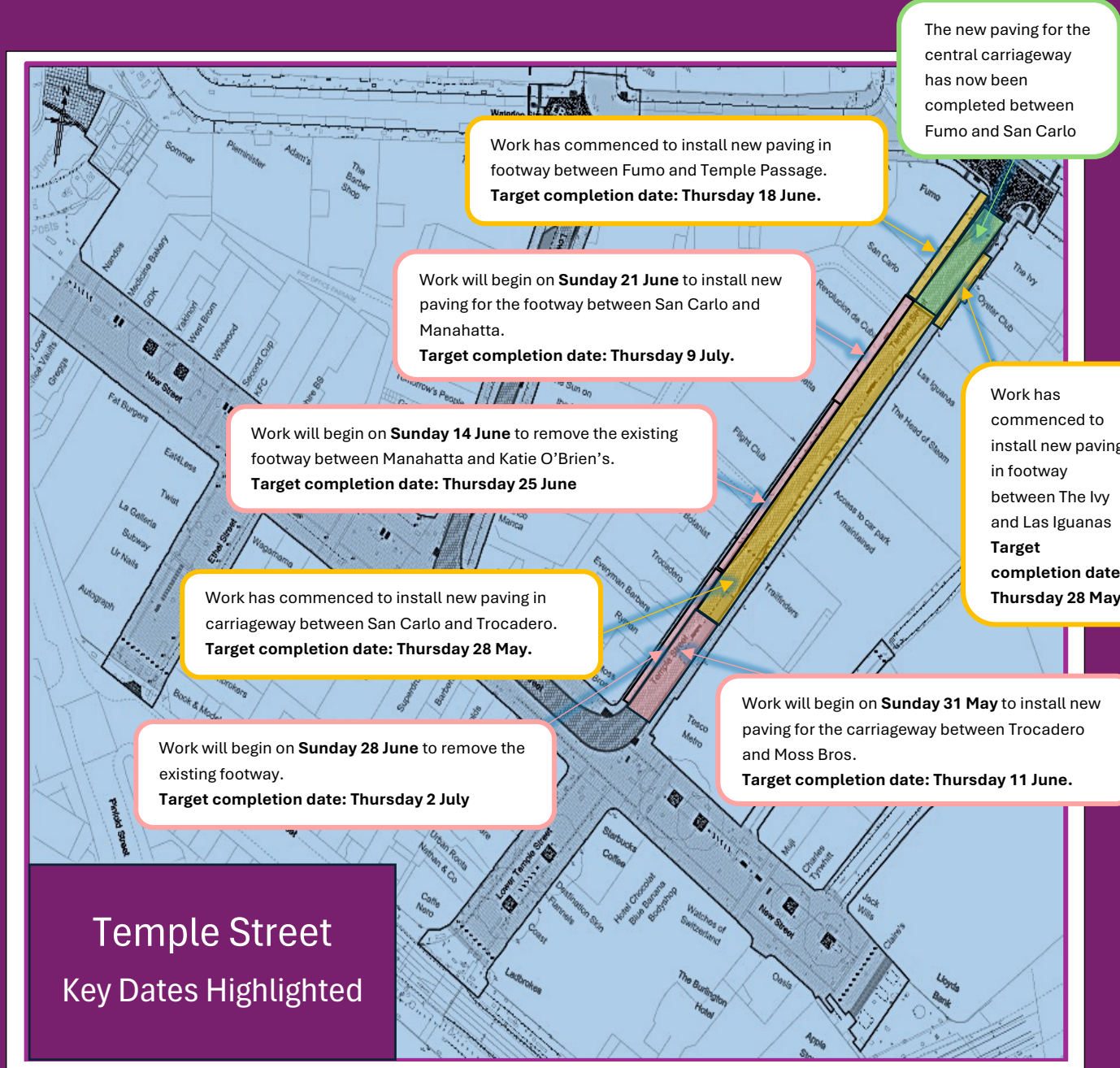
CPC Civils have been awarded the City Centre Active Travel Connections to Interchange Phase 1 project by Birmingham City Council.

This edition of the newsletter provides the revised completion target dates that are being proposed across our work areas in New Street and Temple Street.



# Update: Works Progress from 24th April / Works Planned to 24th May 2026

Note: Work in the footways to be undertaken at night.  
For key future dates and planned works – please see diagrams on page 1 and 2.



## TEMPLE STREET

Work continues with new paving being installed to form the new carriageway. Both ends of Temple Street are open to traffic and pedestrians. Access is being maintained to Temple Passage for refuse collections and deliveries. Both the private and public car parks are also accessible.

Work has also commenced in the footway adjacent to Fumo (at Temple Street/Temple Row junction).



## NEW STREET (NANDO'S)

Footbridges have now been installed to ensure that access is maintained to the businesses between Tortilla and Eat 4 Less while work to form the new footway is undertaken.

New paving continues to be installed in the carriageway and this has progressed to the Ethel Street/New Street junction.



## NEW STREET (APPLE)

Footbridges have now been installed to ensure that access is maintained to the businesses between Lloyds Bank and Charles Tyrwhitt while work is undertaken to remove the old footway in preparation for the new paving.

Work also continues to install the new paving to form the new carriageway. This work continues to progress towards the Lower Temple Street/New Street junction.



## VICTORIA SQUARE

Work continues to number and carefully remove steps (left side of fountain) for transfer to the storage yard, manufacture the steps that require replacement, and make good the concrete foundation beneath the steps to prepare for re-laying of steps.
